Biography

New York-based professional vocal ensemble, **The Salvatones**, consists of passionate, committed singers led by artistic director Daniel Brondel, Associate Director of Music and Organist at St. Patrick's Cathedral. Co-founded with President Salvatore Diana, The Salvatones' mission is to inspire and improve lives through high-quality music and creative community engagement. Since 2010, they have delivered consummate vocal artistry, delighting audiences in concerts, as well as private and public events, having performed for thousands as part of the St. Patrick's Cathedral Guest Choir Concert Series. The Salvatones have appeared throughout New York City and Westchester, New Jersey, Connecticut, Maryland, Ohio, and most recently Texas. The Salvatones have also collaborated with several internationally-renowned vocal ensembles including The Philippine Madrigal Singers, Essence of Joy Singers, and DeKoor Close Harmony. In 2014, they released their first commercial recording, *Wonderful World*, available to download and purchase, and in 2018, the ensemble released their first professional music video.

In 2016, they performed the work of Pulitzer Prize-winning composer Jennifer Higdon as part of the Paul Creston Award ceremony hosted by acclaimed conductor Gerard Schwarz. In 2017, they participated in a national video project sponsored by Americans for the Arts advocating for the preservation of funding for the National Endowment for the Arts. In 2018, they presented the New York premiere of Saunder Choi's *The New Colossus* based on the iconic Emma Lazarus poem. The Salvatones' annual concert series frequently features collaborations with area artists such as the New York Virtuosi string ensemble, and have included the programs: the Many Sounds of Christmas, the Many Sounds of Spring, and American Reflections. As part of their mission to foster creative community engagement, The Salvatones have developed "Young Voices," a major educational initiative that places young singers in collaborative concerts to facilitate dynamic learning experiences.
